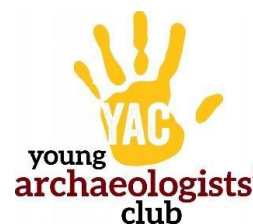


Dig It! Competition 2019 Terms and Conditions

– Fowler’s Pottery



- 1) The competition is open to residents of the UK, Jersey, Guernsey and the Isle of Man.
- 2) **CLOSING DATE:** The last day to send in submissions for the competition is May 26th 2019.
- 3) To enter please answer the question as stated on the competition page.
- 4) The winner of each category will receive a day of archaeological experience at Fowler’s Pottery, hosted by Lough Neagh Landscape Partnership and Queen’s University Belfast and a pack of archaeological tools.
- 5) Entrants must be aged 8 or over **and** be a member of the Young Archaeologists’ Club (YAC).
- 6) Each entrant may submit up to three entries. If more entries are received the judges will only consider the first three entries.
- 7) Each winner must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 8) Each winner is responsible for their own travel to site and back.
- 9) Each winner must be available on June 8th 2019.
- 10) Entrants can withdraw from the competition at any time by emailing yac@yac-uk.org
- 11) **How to Enter**
 - i) Please email your answer to yac@yac-uk.org marked Dig It! Competition – Fowler’s Pottery
 - (1) Your email should include your name and age on 8th June 2019. Please confirm in the email that you have permission from your parent/carer to enter the competition.
- 12) The winning entries will be picked at random, from a hat, by a member of the Council for British Archaeology’s staff. The decision will be final.
- 13) The winners will be notified through email by Thursday 30th of May.
