Brief Activity Description: Mediterranean Archaeology

Materials Needed: Images of Islands and modelling materials

Step by step guide to the activity:

- This activity explores the remarkable archaeology on the Mediterranean Islands, such as Malta, Crete, Sicily, and Cyprus. Each island can be dealt with in a different session.
- Begin by giving a short description of the island and its archaeology, ie the culture and history of settlement.
- Follow on from the description with craft activities based on the archaeology of the island:
  - Make models of people and houses which were used as cult objects on Malta and Cyprus
  - Draw a large outline of the island on a piece of paper and get the YAC members to add drawings of sites or key features in a montage fashion
  - In groups build a Greek temple out of card or similar. For example a large box lid as the platform and rolled corrugated card as the columns. Individuals can contribute towards the freize and pediment decorations
