



## **Dig It! Competition 2026 Terms and Conditions – Ballynahatty, Co. Down**

- 1) The competition is open to residents of the UK, Jersey, Guernsey and the Isle of Man.
- 2) **CLOSING DATE:** The last day to send in submissions for the competition is **31<sup>st</sup> May 2026**.
- 3) To enter please answer the question as stated on the competition page.
- 4) The winner of each category will receive a day of archaeological experience at Ballynahatty, within the Down County, hosted by the University of Belfast and a pack of archaeological tools.
- 5) Each participant will be eligible for the Dig It! Bursary. Information about the bursary is supplied separately.
- 6) Entrants must be aged 8 or over **and** be a member of the Young Archaeologists' Club (YAC).
- 7) Each entrant may submit up to three entries. If more entries are received the judges will only consider the first three entries.
- 8) Each winner must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 9) Each winner is responsible for their own travel to the site and back.
- 10) Each winner must be available on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2026.

- 14) The winners will be notified through email by 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
