



Dig It! Competition 2026 Terms and Conditions

– Bedrule Castle

- 1) The competition is open to residents of the UK, Jersey, Guernsey and the Isle of Man.
- 2) **CLOSING DATE:** The last day to send in submissions for the competition is **12th July 2026**.
- 3) To enter please answer the question as stated on the competition page.
- 4) The winner of each category will receive a day of archaeological experience at Bedrule Castle in the Scottish Borders, hosted by HARP, and a pack of archaeological tools.
- 5) Each participant will be eligible for the Dig It! Bursary. Information about the bursary is supplied separately.
- 6) Entrants must be aged 8 or over **and** be a member of the Young Archaeologists' Club (YAC).
- 7) Each entrant may submit up to three entries. If more entries are received the judges will only consider the first three entries.
- 8) Each winner must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 9) Each winner is responsible for their own travel to the site and back.
- 10) Each winner must be available on **15th August 2026**.
- 11) Entrants can withdraw from the competition at any time by emailing yac@yac-uk.org

- 14) The winners will be notified through email by 17th July 2026.
